

Browser Extension User Guide

The ReliQra browser extension puts your whole collectibles workflow into a single floating **dock** that you can summon on any web page. It's built first for **Whatnot sellers**, but anyone who wants to **identify and price a collectible from anywhere on the web** gets the full toolkit:

- **Scan & identify** a coin, card, or comic live on a stream or from any listing, and get instant pricing — Greysheet for coins, PriceCharting / SportsCardsPro / GoCollect for cards and comics, plus recent eBay comps.
- **Browse and edit your ReliQra inventory** in place — the same account and items as the iOS, Android, and web-portal surfaces.
- **Sync your Whatnot orders** into ReliQra and **mark items Sold** automatically — no manual data entry, no overselling.
- **Calculate melt value** with live metal spot prices, a junk-silver calculator, and a searchable coin browser.
- **Print thermal shipping labels, fill order and shipment data**, and **delist** items that sold elsewhere — all from the same dock.

One account, every surface. The extension signs into the **same ReliQra account** as the iOS and Android apps and the web portal. Your inventory, plan, and Lookup balance are shared — what you scan or edit in the dock shows up everywhere instantly.

01 Install & sign in

- 1 **Install** the ReliQra extension from the Chrome Web Store. It works in any Chromium browser — Chrome, Edge, Brave, Arc, Opera. **Pin it** to your toolbar so the dock is one click away.
- 2 **Open the dock.** Click the **ReliQra toolbar icon** (it toggles the dock open and closed) or press **Alt+Shift+R** on any page. On Whatnot pages the dock opens automatically the first time; after that it remembers whether you left it open or hidden.
- 3 **Sign in** from the **Web** tab's **Account** section — this is the **same login** you use on the ReliQra apps and web portal:
 - **Email & password** — enter them and click **Sign in**. Forgot it? Click **Forgot password?** to get a reset link by email; the link opens a ReliQra page where you set a new password.
 - **Continue with Google** — a browser window opens to pick your Google account, then returns you to the dock automatically.

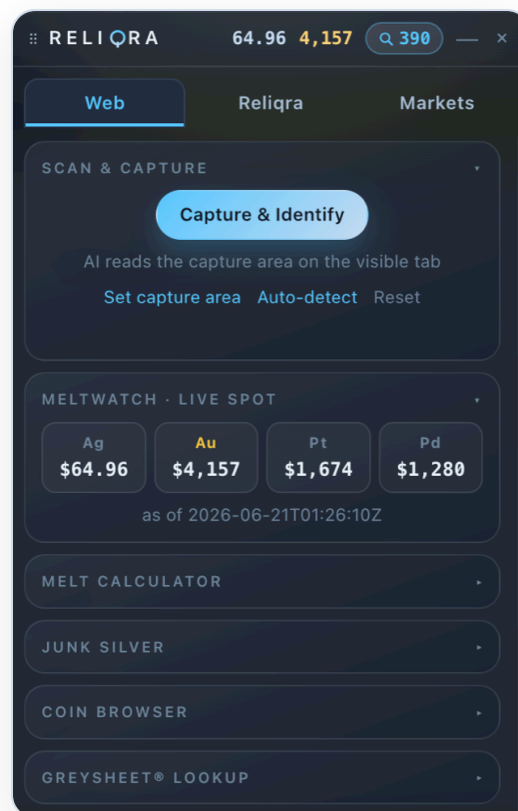
- **Continue with Apple** — opens the same way.

When you're signed in, the **Account** section shows "**Signed in** · *your email*", your **plan badge** (e.g. *Pro* or *Free*), and your **remaining Lookups** (plus any one-time pack credits).

⚠ **Use the same sign-in method everywhere.** If you paid on iOS with Apple "Hide My Email" but then sign into the extension with your real Google address, you'll land in a *second* account that looks Free. Always use the **same** method across surfaces. See *Troubleshooting* below.

02 The dock — anatomy & controls

Everything lives in one draggable, resizable window. Get comfortable with it and the rest of the guide is just "which tab."

The header (always visible). Left to right:

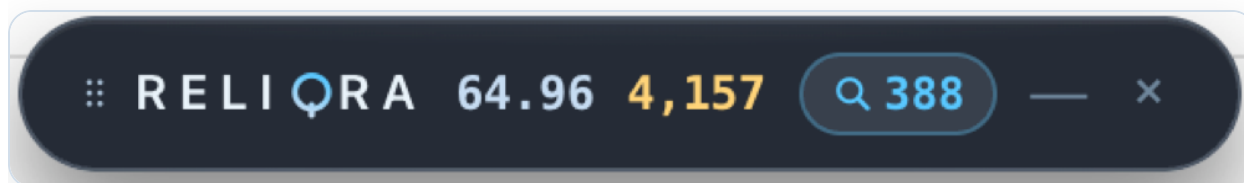
- The **Reliqra wordmark** (also a drag handle).
- **Live silver and gold spot** — the two numbers next to the wordmark (e.g. **64.96** silver, **4,157** gold) update on their own every few minutes.
- **Your Lookups pill** — the magnifying-glass badge (e.g. **390**) shows how many Lookups you have left. It's visible even when the dock is collapsed.
- **Collapse (—)** and **Hide (x)** buttons.

The three tabs:

TAB	WHAT IT'S FOR
Web	Scan & identify, the MeltWatch calculators, manual Greysheet lookup, your account, and settings.
Reliqra	Your live Reliqra inventory — search, open, edit, and add items.
Markets	Whatnot order sync, mark-sold, delisting, fill-order-data, label printing, and eBay quick links.

Moving and sizing it:

- **Drag** the dock by its header to reposition it anywhere on the page.
- **Resize** from the bottom-right corner.
- **Collapse (—)** shrinks the dock to a slim pill that still shows spot prices and your Lookup count — handy while you run a show. Click it to expand again.
- **Hide (×)** dismisses the dock entirely; the toolbar icon or **Alt+Shift+R** brings it back.

Collapsible sections. Inside a tab, each titled section (Scan & Capture, MeltWatch · Live Spot, Melt Calculator, Junk Silver, Coin Browser, Greysheet® Lookup, Account, Settings) has a chevron — click the section title to fold or unfold it. The dock **remembers** which sections you keep open.

03 Capture anywhere — scan & price a coin, card, or comic

This is the headline tool: point the extension at any item on screen — a Whatnot live show, an eBay listing, a Facebook group post, anything — and it identifies and prices it.

How a scan works

- 1 Open the **Web** tab → **Scan & Capture**. Pick a **category** from the dropdown: **Coin**, **Card**, **Comic**, or **Auto-detect**.
- 2 Aim the capture box:
 - **Set capture area** — draw a box around the item. (The box is stored as a *fraction* of the screen, so it stays correct even if the video resizes.)
 - **Auto-detect** — snaps the box to the typical Whatnot live-stream video region.
 - **Reset** — clears your custom area back to the default.
- 3 Click **Capture & Identify**. The first time, your browser asks "**Choose what to share**" — pick the tab or window with your item. The extension reuses that share for later scans, so you only pick once per session.
- 4 The dock grabs one frame, crops it to your box, and shows a **thumbnail of exactly what was sent to the AI** (labeled "**Sent to AI · click to enlarge**"). Use it to confirm you captured the right thing.

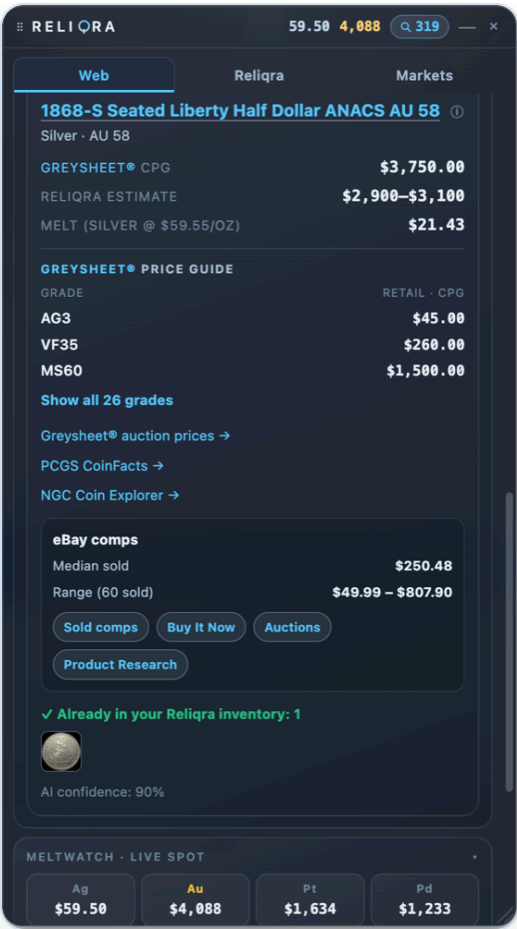


A scan in progress – the dock shows the cropped slab frame captured and sent to the AI

- 1 The result paints in **two stages**: the **identification** appears first, then **prices fill in** a moment later.

Cost: one scan = **1 Lookup**. The AI identification *and* its bundled pricing (Greysheet for coins, market comps for cards/comics) count as a **single** Lookup. Melt value and live spot prices are always free.

Reading a coin result card

A coin card can include all of the following:

FIELD	WHAT IT MEANS
Title	Series / year / mint / denomination the AI identified (e.g. <i>1868-S Seated Liberty Half Dollar ANACS AU 58</i>).
Cert block	If the coin is slabbed , the grader (PCGS, NGC, CAC, ANACS, ICG, etc.) and the cert serial . The serial is editable — fix an OCR mistake and the deep link updates. A " View grader cert → " button opens the grader's verification page.
Greysheet® CPG	The Greysheet Collector Price Guide retail value for the identified grade. The header links to the full Greysheet page.
ReliQRA Estimate	ReliQRA's own dealer-average low–high band, when available.
Melt	The intrinsic metal floor — the coin's metal value at live spot, with the silver/gold price used. This is a <i>floor</i> , not a market price.
Greysheet® price guide	A per-grade table (Retail · CPG). Click " Show all <i>N</i> grades " to expand the full ladder.

FIELD	WHAT IT MEANS
PCGS CoinFacts / NGC Coin Explorer	Deep links to the reference pages for the variety.
eBay comps	Median sold price and the sold-price range (with the number of sales). Buttons jump to live eBay searches: Sold comps , Buy It Now , Auctions , Product Research .
Already in your Reliqra inventory	If the scan matches something you already own, a count + thumbnail appears — click it to open that item in the Reliqra tab.
AI confidence	How sure the model is about the identification (e.g. 90%). Treat low confidence as a prompt to double-check.

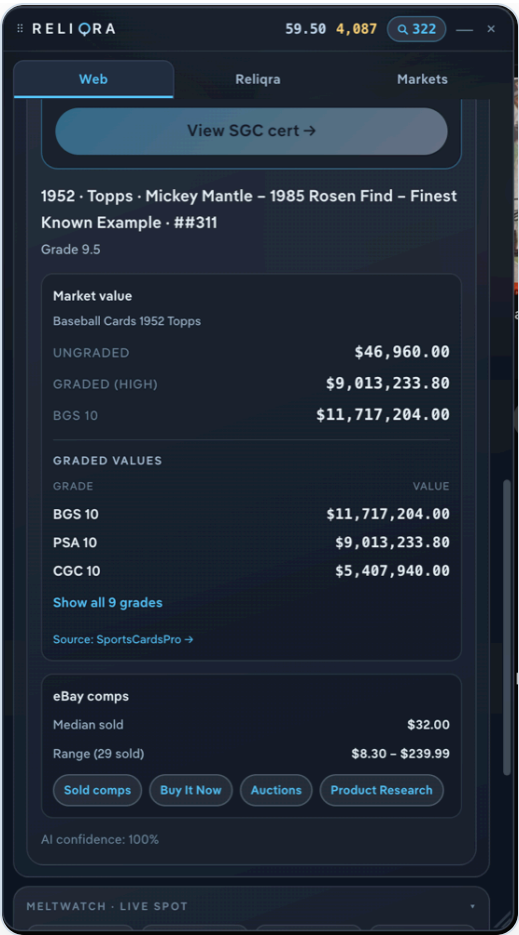
When a slab is detected but the grade or grader couldn't be read, the card lets you **pick the grader** and **edit the serial** yourself so the cert link and pricing resolve correctly.

Greysheet wholesale Bid/Ask is intentionally hidden. Per Reliqra's Greysheet partnership the dock shows **retail CPG** and the **Reliqra Estimate**, not raw dealer Bid/Ask.

Reading a card or comic result card

Pick **Card** or **Comic** (or let **Auto-detect** decide). The layout mirrors coins but is built around the right pricing source for the category.

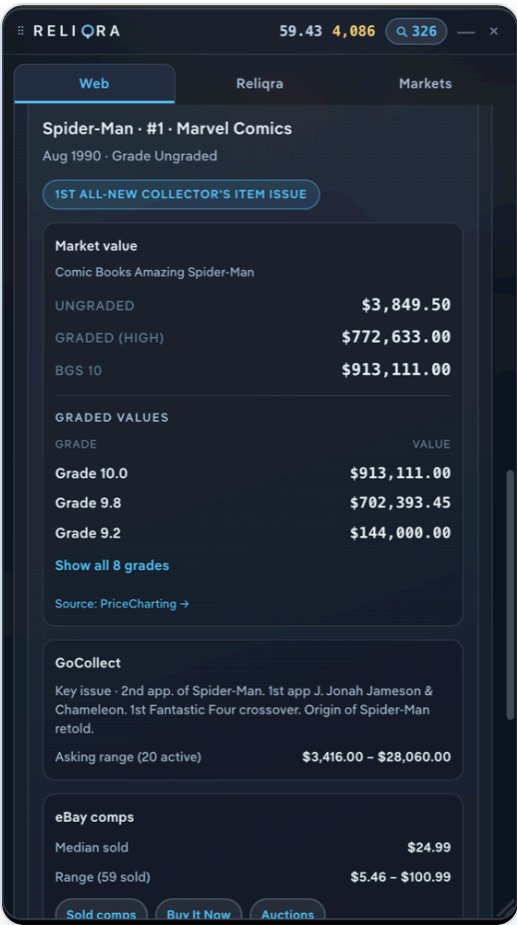




A card scan result for a 1952 Topps Mickey Mantle showing market value tiers, graded values, SportsCardsPro source, and eBay comps

Cards show:

- The identified card (set / year / player / number) and **grade**.
- A "**View grader cert ->**" button with **PSA cert verification** — a ✓ when the serial checks out against PSA.
- **Market value** tiers — **Ungraded**, **Graded (high)**, and a top-grade figure (e.g. *BGS 10*).
- A **Graded values** table per grade (PSA 10, BGS 10, CGC 10, ...) with "**Show all N grades.**"
- **Source: SportsCardsPro** for sports cards (PriceCharting powers the rest).
- **eBay comps** — median sold + range + the same jump buttons.



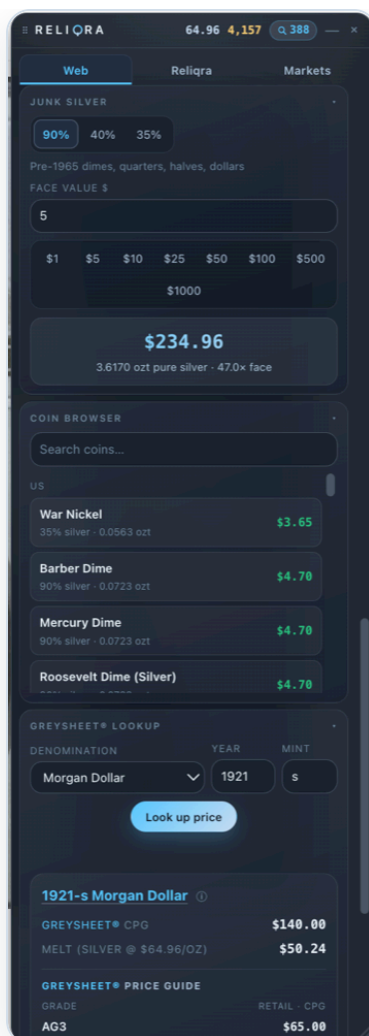
A comic scan result for Amazing Spider-Man #1 showing market value tiers, graded values, the PriceCharting source, a GoCollect key-issue note, and eBay comps

Comics show:

- The identified book and a **key-issue flag** (e.g. *1st all-new collector's item issue*).
- **Market value** tiers (Ungraded / Graded high / top grade) and a **Graded values** grade ladder.
- **Source: PriceCharting**, plus a **GoCollect** key-comments note and a sales/active-listing range.
- **eBay comps** with the usual jump buttons.

04 The MeltWatch tools (Web tab)

Below the scanner, the Web tab carries the full MeltWatch toolkit. **All of it is free — no Lookups.**

- **MeltWatch · Live Spot** — live **Ag / Au / Pt / Pd** spot prices in four cells, timestamped, and refreshing on their own.
- **Melt Calculator** — pick a metal (**Ag / Au / Pt / Pd**) and a unit (**Grams / Troy oz / 1/oz**), enter weight and purity %, and read the melt value, fine troy ounces, and spot/oz. Choosing gold reveals **karat presets** (10K · 14K · 18K · 22K · 24K).
- **Junk Silver** — choose **90% / 40% / 35%**, type a face value (or tap a preset: \$1, \$5, \$10, \$25, \$50, \$100, \$500, \$1000), and get the melt value, pure troy ounces, and the multiplier (e.g. *47.0x face*).
- **Coin Browser** — search a built-in catalog of common silver/gold coins. Each row shows the composition and current melt; **click a coin to auto-fill the calculator**.

The MeltWatch tools share the **spot-price plumbing** with the standalone MeltWatch app but are self-contained inside the extension — they don't draw on any separate MeltWatch balance.

Manual Greysheet® lookup

When you want a price without scanning, open **Greysheet® Lookup**: pick a **denomination**, type a **year** and **mint**, and click **Look up price**. If several varieties match you'll get a candidate list to choose from; the result is the same rich card as a scan (CPG grade table, PCGS/NGC links, eBay comps).

Cost: a manual Greysheet lookup = **1 Lookup** (same as a scan). The melt calculator, junk silver, coin browser, and live spot are free.

05 Your Reliqra inventory (Reliqra tab)

The **Reliqra** tab is your live inventory from Reliqra Cloud — no need to switch to the app.

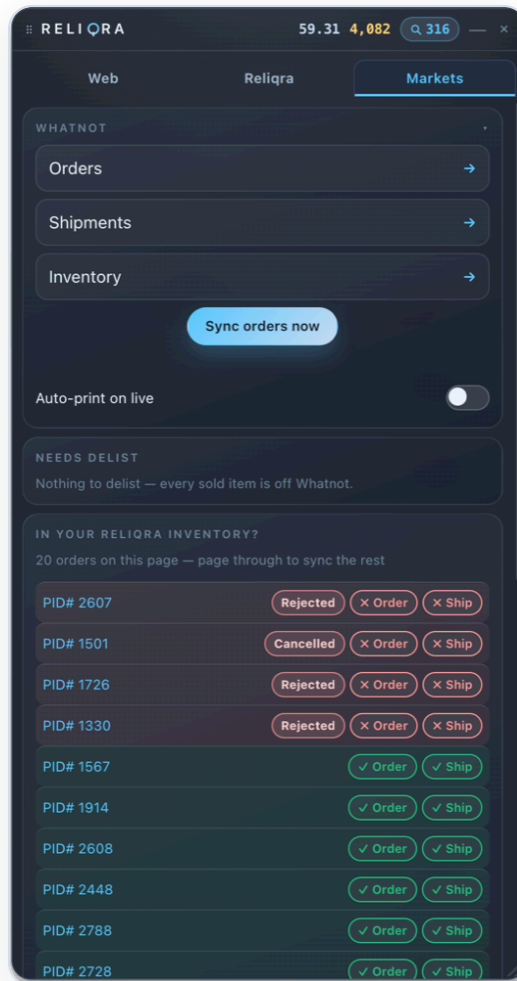


The Reliqra tab showing the inventory list with circular coin thumbnails, PID numbers, grades, statuses, and values

- **Search** ("Search your inventory...") filters by **title, PID#, grade, and status** as you type. The line above the list shows how many of your total items match (e.g. *50 of 1511*).
- **+ Add item** opens a blank form to create a new item.
- **Each row** shows a **thumbnail** — a **circle** for raw coins, a **rounded rectangle** for slabbed ones (matching the iOS/Android apps) — plus the title, **PID# · grade · status**, and the value on the right.
- **Tap a row** to open the item's detail view. It shows **front/back photos** (click to open a full-size, zoomable lightbox) and editable fields: **Title, PID#, Status** (Active / Listed / Sold / Traded / Private / Archived), **Denomination, Year, Mintmark, Grade, Grader, Value \$, Cost \$, Sold \$, Notes**. **Save** to write changes back to Reliqra Cloud (they appear on every surface).
- **Deep link from a scan:** the "Already in your Reliqra inventory" thumbnail on a scan result jumps straight here to the matching item.

06 Whatnot order sync & mark-sold (Markets tab)

This is the extension's flagship seller feature: it reads your **Whatnot orders** and marks the matching items **Sold** in Reliqra — automatically, with no manual data entry.

Read-only on Whatnot. The extension *reads* order data (order number, buyer, item, price, date) as Whatnot pages load. It **never places, changes, or cancels** anything on Whatnot, and it never takes over your account.

Quick links & syncing

The top of the Markets tab has one-click links to your Whatnot **Orders**, **Shipments**, and **Inventory** pages, plus a **Sync orders now** button and an **Auto-print on live** toggle.

How mark-sold works

- 1 Run your show or open your Whatnot **Orders** page. The extension reads each order in the background.
- 2 Orders sync to Reliqra automatically. Reliqra matches each order to an item by its **product ID (PID#)** and **marks it Sold**, which **prevents overselling** across your other channels.

- 3 On the orders page, each order shows two status pills — **Order** and **Ship** (green ✓ when that data is already in Reliqa, red ✕ when it isn't) — and a **status chip** for any non-sale (*Cancelled, Rejected, Refunded, Returned, Declined, Withdrawn, Expired*). A green ✓ **Sold** chip marks items the dock just marked sold in this session.
- 4 A running tally shows **scanned · matched · unmatched · need-delist** counts so you can see the sync's progress at a glance.

Duplicate orders are filtered automatically, and a **status change re-syncs** — e.g. a **Sold → Cancelled** flips the item back so your inventory stays accurate. Turn on **Notify when sold** (Settings) for a small browser notification as each order syncs.

Fill order & shipment data

On a Whatnot **order detail** page, the dock adds a "Fill Reliqa Data" panel with two status pills — **Order Data** and **Shipment Data** (green = already in Reliqa). If one is red, click **Fill** to push that order's details (sale, fees) and shipment tracking into the matching item. If the item isn't in your inventory yet, you can "**Capture as adhoc item.**" On a **shipment** page the panel reads "**Add tracking to Reliqa**" and pushes the carrier + tracking number.

Delist a sold-elsewhere listing

When an item sells on another marketplace, the Markets tab's **Needs delist** worklist flags the matching **active** Whatnot listing so you can take it down. The line reads "*every sold item is off Whatnot*" when nothing needs action.

- Each flagged row shows the item, where it sold, a **Reliqa** button (jump to the item), and a **Delist →** link.
- Delisting drives **Whatnot's own Status → Deactivate** menu, one listing at a time, behind a confirmation gate — it **never bulk-delists**.
- It's limited to accounts whose **role can publish** (owners/admins); other roles see the action disabled with a note to ask an owner or admin.
- If you **arm the gate**, a listing reconciled by a **confirmed eBay sale** can be auto-deactivated for the next **24 hours** when you open that listing's edit page. Other marketplaces stay a manual one-click.

Auto-print labels (opt-in per show)

If you use a thermal label printer, the extension can **auto-print a shipping label** — with the **PID#, grade, buyer, and a QR code to the Reliqa item** — as items sell in a live show.

- It's **opt-in per show**: the first sale shows a banner — "**Reliqa auto-print is ON ... Only print if this is YOUR show**" — with three choices: **Print all + auto-print new sales**, **Auto-print new sales only**, or **Don't print — I'm just watching**.
- A status chip shows the current state: *Auto-print: ON, watching (off for this show), or waiting for your confirmation*.
- It **never reprints** across refreshes and **never prints for shows you're only watching**.

eBay section

The Markets tab also has quick links to your eBay **Orders, Active listings, and Sold & shipments** pages. (eBay listing is already automated elsewhere in Reliqa; deeper in-dock eBay order automation is "*coming — research in progress.*")

07 Settings

The Web tab's **Settings** section has four toggles (they sync across your signed-in browsers):

TOGGLE	WHAT IT DOES
Auto-send captured orders	Push read Whatnot orders to Reliqra automatically instead of clicking Sync orders now .
Auto-refresh orders	Keep the orders view refreshing on its own while you work.
Notify when sold	Show a small browser notification as each order is matched and marked Sold.
Auto-print on live	Allow per-show label auto-printing (still gated by the per-show confirmation banner above).

08 Lookups & upgrading

A **Lookup** is what you spend on paid work:

- **A scan** (AI identify + its bundled pricing) = **1 Lookup**.
- **A manual Greysheet lookup** = **1 Lookup**.
- **Free, always:** the melt calculator, junk silver, coin browser, live spot prices, and **all Whatnot order sync / mark-sold / fill / delist / label printing**.

Your plan badge and remaining Lookups are always visible — in the header pill and in the Account section. When you run out, a scan returns an **upgrade prompt** instead of a result. Plans, prices, and one-time Lookup packs are listed in Identity, Access & Billing — Plans & prices; web/extension checkout runs through Stripe.

09 Privacy & safety, in one place

- **Read-only on Whatnot.** The dock reads order/listing data from pages you open; it never places, edits, or cancels anything, and it never logs into or controls your Whatnot account.
- **Delisting is gated.** It's behind a confirmation, drives Whatnot's own menu one item at a time, and is limited to publish-capable roles.
- **Auto-print is gated.** Opt-in per show, with a "only if it's your show" confirmation, and it never prints for shows you're only watching.
- **Your data syncs to your account only.** Inventory and orders flow into *your* Reliqra tenant; role permissions are enforced server-side regardless of what the dock shows.

10 Troubleshooting & getting help

- **"Paid on iOS, but the extension shows Free."** You're almost certainly signed in with a *different* method than you paid with (commonly Apple "Hide My Email" vs. your real email). Sign out and sign back in with the **same** method you used to pay.
- **A cloud action fails after a while / "Session expired."** Your token expired. The dock refreshes automatically; if a one-off action fails, just retry, or sign in again from the Account section.
- **Apple sign-in fails ("Invalid client id").** Use email/password or **Continue with Google** instead (see §1).
- **The scan box is capturing the wrong thing.** Use **Set capture area** to draw a tight box around the item, or **Reset** then **Auto-detect** to snap back to the stream region. The **"Sent to AI"** thumbnail confirms what was captured.
- **"Choose what to share" keeps reappearing.** The share is reused for the session; if it was stopped (you closed the tab or clicked the browser's "Stop sharing"), the next scan re-prompts — that's expected.

- **Thumbnails won't load on a Whatnot page.** Whatnot's strict content-security policy can block images; the dock routes photos through an internal frame to work around it. If one still won't load, reopen the item from the Reliqra tab.
- **Low AI confidence on a scan.** Re-aim the box tighter, make sure the coin/slab is in focus, and re-scan; for slabs you can also correct the grader and cert serial by hand.
