

iOS App User Guide

ReliQRA lets you **photograph, identify, value, and track** your collectibles — coins, bullion, banknotes, cards, comics, and proof sets — right from your iPhone or iPad. Everything lives in the cloud under one account shared with the Android app, the web portal, and the browser extension, so your collection follows you everywhere. This guide walks through everything the app does.

01 Sign in

When you first open ReliQRA you'll see three ways to sign in. Pick whichever you prefer — they all land you in the **same account**.

- **Sign in with Apple** — tap the Apple button and confirm with Face ID / Touch ID. Fastest on iPhone.
- If you choose Apple's "**Hide My Email**," it creates a *separate* private address. If you later sign in elsewhere (the web portal, the extension) with a *different* method — your real Gmail, say — those can look like two separate accounts. **Use the same sign-in method everywhere.**
- **Sign in with Google** — tap **Continue with Google**; a secure browser sheet opens to pick your account, then returns you to the app.
- **Email & password** — tap **Email & Password**, then **Sign up** (new) or **Sign in** (existing). New sign-ups must **confirm their email**: open the message from *ReliQRA* (noreply@reliqra.com) and tap the link before signing in. Forgot it? Tap **Reset password**.

After you sign in, ReliQRA finishes setting up your workspace and your inventory loads. A brief "**Finishing setup**" message just means your workspace is being created — give it a moment.

02 Getting around — the tab bar & toolbar

Bottom tab bar (left to right):

TAB	WHAT IT'S FOR
Collectibles	Your inventory list — browse, search, filter, and open any item.
CSV Tools	Marketplace exports (Facebook, Whatnot, eBay), auction tools, and reports.
Add (+)	The center button — capture or add a new item.
Tools	Live metal prices, Melt Guard, AI lookup, Greysheet lookup, reconciliation, and more.
Search	A dedicated searchable view of your inventory.

Top toolbar (on the Collectibles tab):

- **Live metal HUD (left)** — current **silver (Ag)** and **gold (Au)** spot prices. Tap to toggle the day's change/percent; long-press to open the metal calculator.
- **QR / barcode scanner** — scan a printed Reliqa label to instantly **Open in detail**, **Mark as Sold**, or **Add to Auction CSV**.

- **Filters** — open the filter sheet (see §3).
- **More (...)** — Edit (multi-select), **Show/Hide Cost**, Settings, Filters, and Pricing Lookup.

03 Your inventory (Collectibles)

The counts at the top summarize your collection: **active** · **sold** · **unreconciled** · **archived** (each shown only when it applies), plus your remaining **Lookups** (magnifying-glass icon). The count chips are tappable filters — tap **unreconciled** to see only items that still need checking off.

Each row shows:

- A **thumbnail** — a **circle** for raw coins, a **rounded rectangle** for slabs, cards, and comics — with a ★ if it's a key date.
- The **title** and **PID#** (the item's permanent Reliqra product ID).
- The **grade** (e.g. *Ungraded, MS-65*), a **status pill**, an **eBay badge** if it's listed, the **cost** (when Show Cost is on), and the **value** in blue.

Status pills: **RECONCILED** (green) · **UNRECONCILED** (amber) · **SOLD** (red) · **TRADED** (amber) · **PRIVATE** (gray).

Reconciled simply means you've confirmed you physically have (or have accounted for) the item — it's a quick way to audit a large collection.

Search, sort & filter:

- **Search** matches title, description, PID, grade, mint mark, and year.
- **Filters** (the filter sheet) cover **status**, **product type**, **denomination**, **key-date tier**, **price range**, **listed-on-eBay**, and **reconciliation**, plus a **Hide Sold/Traded** toggle.
- **Sort** by year, mint mark, or PID, optionally by price (low→high / high→low).
- **Edit mode** (More ▸ Edit) lets you multi-select to **delete** or **bulk-list on eBay**.

04 Add & identify an item

Tap **Add (+)** to capture something new. This is the heart of the app.

- 1 **Choose the type** — **Coin**, **Card**, **Comic**, **Currency**, or **Proof Set**. The form adapts to show the right fields for that type.
- 2 **Photograph it** — the built-in camera lets you shoot a **Front** and **Back** photo, switch between a **circle frame** (raw coins) and a **rectangle frame** (slabs/cards), and pick portrait or landscape. You can also pull from your **Photo Library**. Preview and **retake** before saving.
- 3 **Identify with AI** — Reliqra reads the photos and **auto-fills** the form: year, denomination, mint mark, grade, grader, cert #, composition, weight, and more. (Uses 1 **Lookup**.)
- 4 **Review and edit** anything the AI got wrong, add your **cost**, **notes**, and acquisition details, and set a **status**.
- 5 **Save** — your item appears in the inventory immediately and syncs to your other devices.

Type-specific fields the form can capture include:

- **Coins** — denomination, mint mark, issuer (US / foreign / ancient), condition, composition & silver %, proof flag, designer, mintage, mass, diameter, thickness, edge — and a full **ancient** set (civilization, authority, mint, legends, moneyer) when relevant.

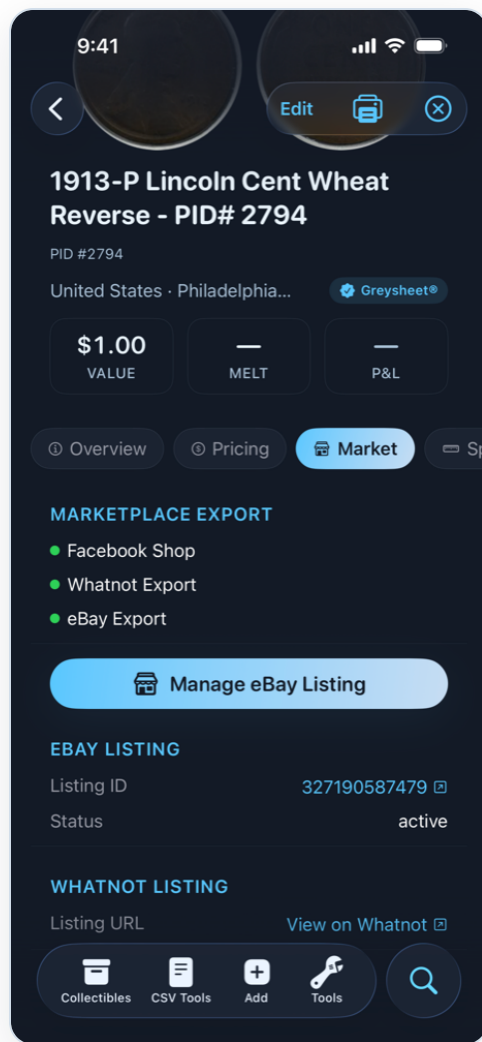
- **Currency** — note type, series, signatures, star note, block, plate number, fancy serial, error type.
- **Cards** — set, series, card number, rarity, publisher.
- **Comics** — issue number, publisher, series.

If eBay is connected, an **auto-list toggle** lets you choose **Don't list** / **List this one** / **Always** when you save.

Lookups: each AI identification uses **1 Lookup**. If you're out, Reliqra shows an upgrade prompt instead of finishing — see §9.

05 The item detail view

Tap any item to open its detail view. The **hero card** at the top shows the photos (tap to zoom), the title, **PID#**, the mint/country, a **Greysheet®** badge when a catalog match is found, and three stat tiles: **VALUE**, **MELT**, and **P&L** (profit/loss — green when you're up, red when down). Use **Edit** to change fields, the **print** button for a QR label, and **×** to close.

Below the hero card are **six tabs**:

TAB	WHAT'S IN IT
Overview	Core details (year, denomination, mint, issuer, country), condition & grading (grader, grade, cert #), notes, status, acquisition date, and an interactive Reconciled toggle.
Pricing	Value, cost, melt value , and the P&L math; the Greysheet widget (CPG retail, grade grid, auto-fetch); purchase details; and, once sold, the full sale record (sold price/date, fees).
Market	Selling — see §6.
Specs	Composition, silver %, weight, diameter, thickness, edge; numismatic specs (designer, mintage, die axis); type-specific specs for currency/cards/comics; and a melt snapshot with a Recompute Melt button.
History	The item's transaction/edit timeline.
Photos	Full-screen, zoomable gallery of the front/back photos.

06 Selling — eBay & Whatnot (Market tab)

The **Market** tab of an item is your selling hub.

- **Marketplace export** shows where the item can go — **Facebook Shop**, **Whatnot Export**, and **eBay Export**.
- **List on eBay / Manage eBay Listing** opens the listing flow. Reliqra walks you through the required fields (title, quantity, price, condition, category aspects) and, once live, shows the **eBay Listing** section with the **Listing ID** (tap to open on eBay), **Status** (active / sold / ended), and last-synced time.
- **Whatnot Listing** shows the listing ID and a **View on Whatnot** link. If an item is marked **Sold** but still live on Whatnot, a banner warns you to **delist it so you don't sell it twice**.

Other ways to sell & reconcile:

- **Bulk-list on eBay** — from the inventory's Edit mode, select items and tap **List on eBay**.
- **Mark as Sold** — change status in Edit mode, or scan an item's QR label and choose **Mark as Sold**. Marking sold automatically clears its marketplace-export flags.
- **Auctions** — tag items (via the QR scanner's **Add to Auction CSV**, or in CSV Tools) for a Whatnot or eBay auction, then export or list them as a batch.

Tip for Whatnot live shows: the **Reliqra browser extension** reads your Whatnot orders and marks the matching items **Sold** automatically as they come in — see the Browser Extension User Guide.

07 Tools

The **Tools** tab is a toolbox of collector utilities. The free ones never cost a Lookup.

Metal prices & melt:

- **Check Latest Metal Prices** — live **gold**, **silver**, **platinum**, **palladium** with day-change indicators, plus a **metal price calculator** for gram/oz/fractional conversions. (*Free.*)

- **Melt Guard (Silver)** — scans your active inventory for silver coins priced **below melt** (or missing the specs needed to compute it), with a high-premium cutoff slider. It can **apply price floors** to under-melt coins, **apply reductions** to over-melt ones, **fill missing specs**, and share a report. *(Free.)*

Collector tools:

- **AI Item Lookup** — identify a coin, card, comic, or banknote from a photo **without** saving it to inventory. *(Metered — 1 Lookup.)*
- **Pricing Lookup (Greysheet)** — look up a price by **year, denomination, mint, proof, and grade**; returns the **Greysheet Retail CPG** plus a **Reliqa Estimate** range and a grade-by-grade grid. *(Metered — 1 Lookup.)*
- **Certification Checker** — verify a slab's cert serial against the grader's site.
- **Lookup History** — review your past AI and Greysheet lookups and report a wrong result.

Reconciliation & maintenance: an **Inventory Audit** (count audit by denomination), **Sales Reconcile (PID)** (compare a sold-PID list against inventory), **Find Duplicate Items**, and a **Marketplace Dashboard** (eBay connection + listing health).

08 CSV Tools

The **CSV Tools** tab generates marketplace-ready exports and auction files:

- **Generate Facebook / Whatnot / eBay CSV** — export your inventory in each marketplace's format (eBay uses File Exchange).
- **Auction tools** — pick **Whatnot** or **eBay**, generate an **Auction CSV** of tagged items, and optionally **List on eBay via API** for publish-capable accounts; **Clear Auction Tags** when done.

09 Lookups & upgrading to Pro

A **Lookup** is the unit you spend when the app does paid work: **AI identify = 1 Lookup** and **Greysheet price = 1 Lookup**. Free things — the **melt calculator**, **live metal spot prices**, **Melt Guard**, **saving items**, and **CSV export** — cost **nothing**. Your remaining Lookups always show in the inventory header.

Plans, prices, and one-time Lookup packs are listed in Identity, Access & Billing — Plans & prices.

To upgrade:

- 1 When you hit your limit, Reliqa shows an **upgrade screen** automatically — or open it anytime.
- 2 Tap **Upgrade to Pro** (or choose a Lookup pack). Apple's purchase sheet appears; confirm with Face ID / Touch ID.
- 3 Your new allowance applies right away and upgrades your account across **all** Reliqa surfaces.

10 Settings

The **Settings** screen (via the More menu or Tools) covers:

- **Account** — your Reliqa email, **Sign out**, **Delete account**, and iCloud sync status.
- **Business account** — if you're on a team, switch organizations and see your role (Owner / Admin / Lister / Viewer) and business name.

- **Marketplace** — connect/disconnect **eBay** (and Whatnot where enabled), and set your **markup %** and **package weight**.
 - **Greysheet® API key (BYOK)** — advanced users can enter their **own** Greysheet key + token to see Greysheet's **wholesale Bid/Ask**. Those lookups draw from **your** key, not your Reliqra Lookups. **Save Key / Clear Key**, with a status line.
 - **Stay updated** — subscribe to the Reliqra newsletter.
 - **Legal & about** — privacy policy, terms, app version.
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11 Getting help

- **Your tier shows Free after you paid, or your inventory looks empty.** Almost always a sign-in mismatch — confirm you're signed in with the **same method** you used elsewhere (Apple "Hide My Email" creates a separate private address). Sign out and back in with the matching method.
 - **AI got the item wrong.** Edit the fields by hand, and use **Lookup History** ▶ **report wrong result** so we can improve identification.
 - **An item sold but is still live on a marketplace.** Open its **Market** tab and follow the delist banner so you don't sell it twice.
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
